

Pre-Circumcision Instructions

Here's a guide for parents to prepare for their newborn's circumcision:

Understand the Procedure

- Research:
 - Read about circumcision, its benefits, risks, and the reasons it may be performed.
 - Visit the FAQ section on our website
- Discuss with Physician:
 - Schedule a consultation with the physician to ask questions and address concerns.
 - We offer virtual & in-person consultations

Informed Consent

- Consent Form:
 - Make sure your questions have been answered, you have thoroughly read the consent form, feel comfortable with proceeding, and sign the Circumcision consent form.

Medical History

- Share Information:
 - Provide a complete medical history of your baby. Please let your physician know if there is any family history of bleeding disorders, infections, or urological conditions.

Anesthesia Options

- Discuss Pain Management:
 - We will prescribe EMLA cream, which will numb the skin to relieve pain and minimize discomfort. You will apply the cream around the penis at least 60



minutes before the procedure. We also inject lidocaine around the penis to ensure your baby is completely pain-free during the procedure.

Preoperative Instructions

- Feeding:
 - You can feed your baby up to 1 hour before the procedure and he will be hungry right after. We have comfortable, private spaces where you can feed your baby after the circumcision.

Hygiene Preparation

- Bathing:
 - Give your baby a gentle bath the night before or the morning of the procedure to ensure cleanliness.

Day of the Procedure

- Dress Comfortably:
 - Dress your baby in loose-fitting and easy-to-remove clothing. We will keep your baby warm and comfortable during the procedure.
- Bring Comfort Items:
 - Bring a favorite blanket or toy to help soothe your baby after the circumcision.
- Pacifier:
 - For babies, sucking is a natural calming reflex. Please bring a pacifier so we can dip it in sugar water, which will distract and soothe him during the procedure.
- Diaper:
 - Please bring an extra diaper so we can put him in a clean diaper after the procedure is completed.
- Anesthetic Cream



 Please apply the anethestic cream that was prescsribed during your pre-Circumcision consult to the base of the penis and loosely cover the area with saran wrap.
